TAA WELCOMES CHANCE TO RESTORE SYDNEY'S STATUS AS AUSTRALIA'S GLOBAL CITY

The state's peak tourism accommodation organisation Tourism Accommodation Australia NSW has welcomed the release of the Joint Select Committee's report into Sydney's night-time economy.

TAA NSW CEO Michael Johnson made a submission to the Parliamentary Committee on Friday, 10 August 2019 where he warned action needed to be taken to restore Sydney's reputation as an international city.

"TAA made a submission to the Joint Select Committee and we welcome the release of its report today," he said.

"It contains a number of sensible recommendations which, if implemented, will assist in enhancing Sydney's nightlife and restoring our status as Australia's only global city.

"These include removing the 1.30am blanket lockout in the Sydney CBD, recommendations for 24hr public transport on weekends, the streamlining of the application process for liquor licensing and development applications and improved safety measures for the city."
